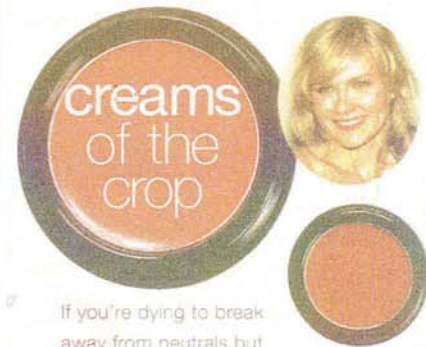

PRO TIP

Increased sweat and oil production during the summer can make large pores look even bigger. To shrink them, celebrity makeup artist Elaine Offers, who has worked on Meg Ryan and Cate Blanchett, recommends prepping your skin with a pore-filling primer, such as Clinique's Pore Minimizer Instant Perfector (left). Then, using a damp makeup sponge, apply a light- to medium-coverage, oil-free foundation without any shimmer or luminosity (both call unwanted attention to pores).
